What Is a Trust Wallet Address?

Your **Trust Wallet address** is a unique alphanumeric string that lets you receive cryptocurrencies and tokens. Each blockchain (like Ethereum, BNB Smart Chain, Tron, etc.) has its own address format.

For example:

- **Ethereum (ERC20) address** usually starts with 0x...
- **BNB Smart Chain (BEP20) address** also starts with 0x...
- **Tron (TRC20) address** starts with T...

That's why knowing **how to find your wallet address in Trust Wallet** based on the token and network type is critical.

This is how you **find wallet address in Trust Wallet** for any supported coin.

How to Find BEP20 Address in Trust Wallet

To **find your BEP20 address in Trust Wallet**, follow these steps:

1. Open Trust Wallet
2. Tap **"Smart Chain"** (not "BNB")
3. Tap **"Receive"**
4. Copy the address shown (it starts with 0x)

This is your **BEP20 wallet address in Trust Wallet**.

How to Find ERC20 Address in Trust Wallet

Looking for your **ERC20 address in Trust Wallet**? It's simple:

1. Open the app
2. Tap on **Ethereum**
3. Tap **“Receive”**
4. Copy the address

Both Ethereum and BNB Smart Chain addresses look similar but are used on different networks. Always double-check before making a transaction.

How to Find TRC20 Address in Trust Wallet

To receive TRC20 tokens (like USDT-TRON), you'll need your **TRC20 wallet address**:

1. Go to Trust Wallet
2. Tap on **Tron (TRX)**
3. Tap **“Receive”**
4. Copy the address (starts with T...)

This address is only valid for **TRC20 tokens** on the Tron network.

How to Find Contract Address in Trust Wallet

A **contract address** is different from your personal wallet address. It refers to the smart contract that governs a token on the blockchain.

To **find a contract address in Trust Wallet**:

1. Search the token on **CoinMarketCap** or **CoinGecko**
2. Scroll down to view the contract address
3. Make sure you select the correct network (e.g., BEP20, ERC20)

You **don't need a contract address to receive funds**, but you do if you're manually importing a custom token into Trust Wallet.

You can safely **share your Trust Wallet address** (public address) with anyone to receive crypto. However, **NEVER share your recovery phrase**, which gives full access to your funds.

- Always double-check the network
- Test with small amounts first
- Avoid sending tokens to the wrong blockchain
