Our program promotes collaborative interdisciplinary research with our global partners, further enhancing the educational experience.

WHAT ARE WE SEEKING IN A SCHOLAR?

McDonnell Scholars are chosen for their potential to become future leaders and are supported in developing their leadership, communication, and critical thinking skills. In selecting our Scholars, we consider:

- Academic distinction: Scholars are selected on the basis of their academic talent, and ambition to become leaders in their chosen profession or community.
- Global mindset: Scholars share a global outlook, embrace difference, and are interested in broader social and cultural issues.
- **Leadership:** Scholars demonstrate a desire and potential to generate positive change in their communities and around the world.
- **Community:** Scholars are part of a diverse, close-knit community. They engage in the Academy's academic, professional, and social activities.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be a graduate or professional degree candidate who has applied to an eligible WashU doctoral or master's degree program. Applicants from all countries and institutions are welcome to apply, whether you are a graduate of one of our esteemed partner universities or from other domestic and international institutions outside our partner network.

HOW TO APPLY

The McDonnell Academy application is a separate application in the WashU graduate application portal. After you submit your application to an eligible WashU doctoral or master's degree program, a link to apply for the McDonnell Academy fellowship will become available on your WashU graduate application status portal. For programs not included the WashU graduate application portal, you will be provided with specific instructions on how to apply for the McDonnell Academy fellowship following the submission of your program application.

Follow these steps for success:

- 1. Apply to an <u>eligible doctoral or master's degree</u> at WashU. Submit the required materials for the WashU graduate program by the program deadline.
- 2. After completing your degree program application, you can access the McDonnell Academy application online via your WashU graduate application status portal. The McDonnell Academy application consists of the following components: a personal essay and a short video.
- 3. Submit the required materials for the McDonnell Academy application before January 31, 2026, 11:59 PM EST.
