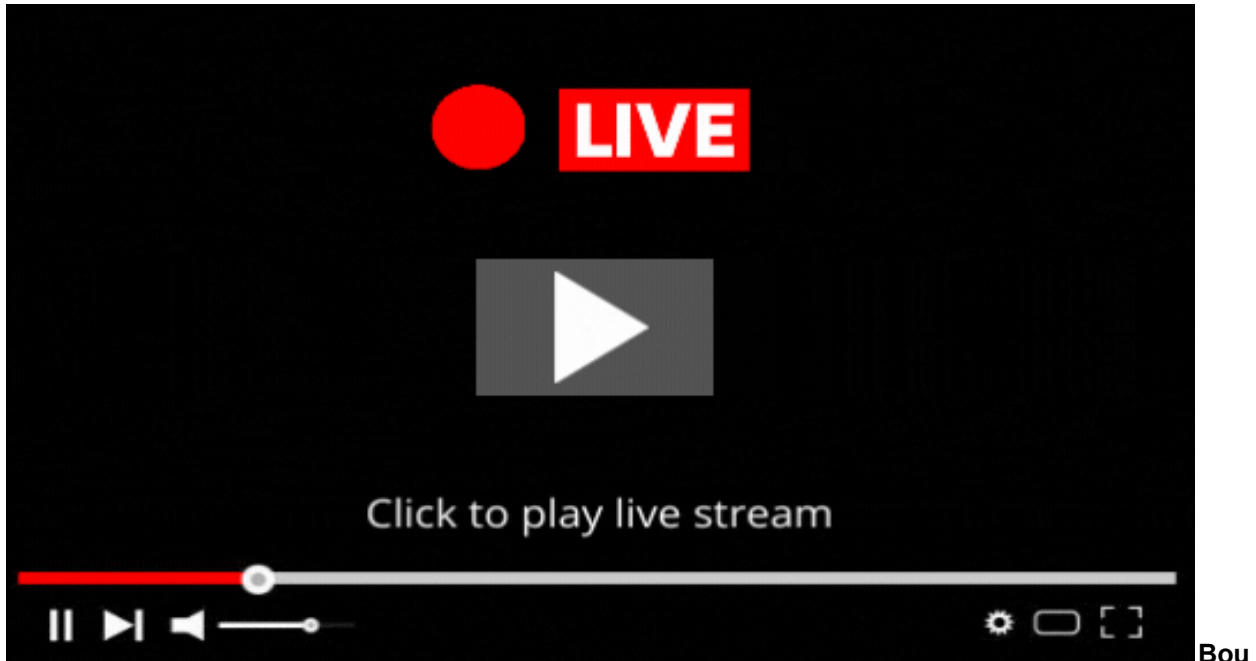


WATCH!*Canelo Álvarez vs Terence Crawford live updates

The wait for Canelo Alvarez's superfight against Terence Crawford is finally over. September 13 has arrived, and boxing fans are crowding into Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas, Nevada, as we speak, in preparation for what's the biggest boxing event on the 2025 calendar to see Crawford challenge Canelo for his IBF, WBC, WBF, WBO, and Ring Magazine super middleweight world titles.

What's more, millions upon millions of fans will be tuning in to this fight on Netflix (as it's free with a subscription) to see what UFC CEO and legendary promoter Dana White's first foray into promoting a boxing event alongside Turki Alalshikh.

Arguably the biggest fight of the year is here. Canelo Alvarez and Terence Crawford are set to throw down in an undisputed super middleweight title fight on Saturday night inside Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas. The fight has the opportunity to add to the legacy of both men as they near the end of storied runs inside the ring.

Crawford has plenty of history at stake on Saturday. The native of Omaha, Nebraska, earned undisputed status in two divisions -- junior welterweight and welterweight -- and boasts an incredible resume. His biggest win came back in 2023 when he demolished fellow unbeaten Errol Spence Jr. to earn all four titles at 147 pounds in one of the biggest fights of the year. Now, Crawford can become the first fighter to accomplish the feat in three divisions with a win on Saturday.

Alvarez has not exactly made fans happy in the last few years with his choice in opponents. The undisputed champ has faced the likes of unknown John Ryder, former junior middleweight champion Jermell Charlo who moved up two weight classes, fellow countrymen Jaime Munguia, a fairly undeserving Edgar Berlanga and then William Scull as a mandatory to earn his IBF title back that he was stripped of.

Now, he seems to be earning back some good will with taking on a fellow pound for pound great, but Crawford is also moving up (at least) two divisions as well. However, the images from the faceoffs might tell a different story as Crawford has looked as big, if not bigger, than Alvarez throughout the build to the fight.

Allegiant Stadium, with a seating capacity of about 65,000, will serve as an appropriate site for the boxing match between Canelo Alvarez vs. Terence Crawford on Saturday, Sept. 13, in Las Vegas.

A big fight deserves a big site.

Make no mistake, this is a mega fight. Featuring two boxers who have spent time atop the sport's pound-for-pound rankings, enjoying Netflix's global platform. And with Alvarez's undisputed super middleweight championship on the line.

But more than championship belts are at stake. So are the boxers' legacies, with the 35-year-old Alvarez (63-2-2, 39 KOs) and the 37-year-old Crawford (41-0, 31 KOs) entering the final stage of their careers.

This massive match will help determine their place in boxing history.
